This petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.65 dated 19.4.2019, under Section 61 of Punjab Excise Act, 1914, registered at Police Station Sunam, District Sangrur. The petitioner apprehended his arrest at the hands of Police in the above FIR.

On 22.7.2019, this Court had passed the following order :-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the FIR contains only secret information regarding illicit liquor in vehicle No.HR- 46-E-2554. It is pointed out that neither the petitioner is involved in any other case nor the vehicle belongs to him.

Notice of motion for 21.11.2019.

In the meanwhile, petitioner shall join the investigation and would come present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, he shall be admitted to interim bail on his furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel, who is assisted by ASI Major, has apprised the Court that pursuant to order dated 22.7.2019 passed by this Court, the petitioner has not joined the investigation.

Considering the conduct of the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed.
