In the present writ petition, notice of motion has been issued on 25.10.2016 and the same is pending for the last two years but no reply has been filed so far. The claim of the petitioner is for the release of the retiral benefits.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that for the relief as claimed in the present writ petition, the petitioner has served the respondents with a legal notice dated 01.09.2016 (Annexure P-6) and the petitioner will be satisfied in case a time bound direction is issued to respondent No.4 to decide the said legal notice by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Learned counsel for the respondents states that he has no objection in case the present writ petition is disposed of by giving direction to respondent No.4 to decide the legal notice dated 01.09.2016 (Annexure P-6) in a time bound manner.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by him in the legal notice dated 01.09.2016 (Annexure P-6), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4 to decide the legal notice dated 01.09.2016 (Annexure P-6) within a period of three months from the receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case, it is found that the petitioner is entitled for any monetary benefits after the decision of the legal notice, the same should also be paid to him within three months thereafter.
