Petitioner Jagmeet Singh @ Babbu has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.14 dated 06.02.2019, registered at Police Station Gidderbaha, District Sri Muktsar Sahib, under Section 22 of the NDPS Act, 1985.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

The Registry has reported that the first bail application of the present petitioner has been dismissed by this Court vide order dated 05.04.2019 and in the present petition, it is nowhere mentioned by him that it is the second petition.

Learned counsel for the petitioner when asked about this fact, he stated that the petitioner has not brought this fact to his notice that the earlier anticipatory bail application has been dismissed by this Court.

Keeping in view the conduct of the petitioner by concealing the material facts from the Court and has tried to mislead the Court, no ground is made out for grant of anticipatory bail to him. The same is dismissed

with costs of Rs.10,000/-. The petitioner is directed to deposit costs with ld. CJM concerned within one month from today.

If the petitioner fails to deposit the costs within the stipulated period, then ld. CJM concerned is directed to get it recovered as arrears of land revenue from the petitioner.
