This order of mine shall dispose of two Civil Writ Petitions bearing No.19857 and 19907 of 2019 as the common question of law is involved.

Petitioners have approached this Court for issuance of directions to the respondents to consider their case for appointment being eligible to the post of PGT (Music) by granting exemption from HTET Pass Certificate.

In pursuance to the advertisement No.5/2015, many posts were sought to be filled by carving out reservation of various categories. As per

the result declared on 02.07.2019, 16 posts of general category, 16 posts of SC, 8 posts of BCA and many other posts remained vacant due to non-availability of the eligible candidates.

Mr. Raje Ram Kaushik, learned counsel representing the petitioners submitted that the petitioners have not passed the HTET examination. There are instructions of the Government, whereby relaxation for passing HTET test has been granted, which is valid upto 2022.

I am afraid that the aforementioned issue cannot be redressed through the intervention of the Court as it is the domain of the respondents not to fill up the posts from the persons who are not eligible. No ground for interference is made out. Resultantly, the writ petitions are dismissed.
