Additional Affidavit on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 6 has been filed in Court today. The same is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner agrees that the relief for which the present petition was filed has already been extended to the petitioner. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the claim of the petitioner for leave encashment for a period of 10 days and Leave Travel Concession as well as interest on the delayed payment is still to be considered by the respondents. Learned counsel for the petitioner prays that petitioner be given liberty to approach the respondents by making a representation for the claim of the leave encashment for a period of 10 days and Leave Travel Concession as well as for interest on the delayed payments .

Learned counsel for the respondents states that in case any

representation is received, the same will be considered in accordance with law and appropriate order will be passed within a period of 3 months of the receipt of the same.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that keeping in view the statement of the learned counsel for the respondents, no grievance of the petitioner survives at this stage and he does not press this writ petition any further and writ petition be disposed of as not pressed.

Ordered accordingly.
