Counsel for the petitioner is unable to dispute the fact that an agreement has been entered into between the petitioner as well as Solar Power Pvt. Ltd., which generates electricity from sun.

If that be so, there is no grievance left out as far as the petitioner is concerned as he would not require water for the said project.

This is apparent from the fact that nothing has been placed on record which

would indicate that for the running of the said project, water would be essential.

In view of the above, the writ petition is disposed of with the observations that the grievance of the petitioner does not survive.
