The present contempt petition has been filed pleading that there is wilful disobedience of the order dated 18.1.2019 passed by this Court in CWP No. 1390 of 2019. The operative part of the said order is reproduced below:

“Without examining the case on merits and without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the writ petition with a direction to respondent No. 3 i.e. The Municipal Council, Samana, District Patiala, to examine the claim of the petitioner-Society against the backdrop of a representation dated 4.12.2018 (Annexure P-2) which is stated to have been already submitted.

A final view with regard to the claim of the petitioner-Society be taken expeditiously and in any case within a period

of eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case any payment is found due to the petitioner-Society, the same would be released without any further delay.”

As per order dated 18.1.2019, the respondents had to take a decision on the representation of the petitioner expeditiously and in any case within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

As per the averments made in the petition, copy of the order passed by this Court was sent to the respondents which was received vide receipt No. 99 dated 23.1.2019. Though the time granted by this court has elapsed, yet another opportunity is granted to the respondents to ensure compliance of the order dated 18.1.2019 within three months from the receipt of copy of this order. In case of non-compliance, costs may be imposed which shall be recoverable from the defaulting official.

With the aforesaid observation, the contempt petition stands disposed of.
