The grievance of petitioner raised was that in spite of order dated 21.5.2019 (Annexure-P-1) passed by Customs, Excise and Service Tax Appellate Tribunal, Chandigarh Bench, Chandigarh in favour of petitioner ordering release of detained goods, upon accepting the declared value of metal scrap, respondent No. 2 had taken no steps to release goods.
