1. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents states that counseling for B. Pharmacy course as is the subject matter of the instant writ petition stands concluded and in pursuance thereto 1500 students have been admitted in 38 different colleges in the State of Haryana. Learned counsel states that in the circumstances the writ petition be disposed of as having become infructuous.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in the light of the position as noted above, he does not press the writ petition subject to the respondents undertaking that in future counseling for B. Pharmacy course for the session 2020-2021 would be conducted by the respondents at its own level and not through a third party.

3. Learned counsel for the respondent's on instructions from Mr. H.K. Aggarwal, Registrar, Pt. Bhagwat Dayal Sharma University

of Health Sciences undertakes that counseling for B. Pharmacy course for the session 2020-2021 would be conducted by the respondents at the University level only and not through a third party.

4. The same satisfies learned counsel for the petitioner.

5. In view of the statement of learned counsel for the parties, the writ petition is disposed of as having become infructuous. However, the respondents shall abide by the undertaking given by learned counsel for the respondents on instructions from Mr. H.K. Aggarwal, Registrar, Pt. Bhagwat Dayal Sharma University of Health Sciences.
