[1] At the very outset, learned counsel states that the petitioner had submitted objections to the respondent/Board vide representation, Annexure P-9 dated 29.03.2019 regarding answer keys, Annexure P-4 uploaded by the respondent/Board qua the STET-2018 Examination conducted by it, but till date, no decision has been taken in respect thereto.

[2] Learned counsel contends that in the circumstances the petitioner would be satisfied if the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent/Board to consider and decide the representation, Annexure P-9 dated 29.03.2019 expeditiously.

[3] In view of the innocuous nature of the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent/Board to consider and decide the representation, Annexure P-9, dated 29.03.2019 in accordance with the rules and regulations and law applicable as expeditiously as possible preferably

within a period of one month from the date of submission of certified copy of this order along with the representation, Annexure P-9 dated 29.03.2019.
