TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner who is serving on the post of Junior Engineer under the Punjab State Power Corporation Limited has filed the instant writ petition assailing the order dated 06.06.2019 to the extent of his transfer from Sub Division, Mehta to Sub Division, Baba Bakala.

During the course of arguments, counsel would concede that the petitioner had completed the normal tenure of posting at Sub Division, Mehta of three years. Under such circumstances, no valid ground has been made out for interfering with the impugned transfer.

At this stage, counsel has adverted to the documents placed on record at Annexure P-4 (colly) and which would reflect that the petitioner had undergone an operation on 09.04.2019 and the doctor has advised him complete bed rest upto 25.07.2019. Accordingly, a statement is made at the bar that the scope of the instant petition would be limited only as regards the petitioner being granted extended joining time so as to join on his place of posting at Sub Division, Baba Bakala.

In the light of such prayer having been raised during the course

of arguments, the instant writ petition is dismissed insofar as challenge to the transfer order dated 06.06.2019 at Annexure P-3 is concerned.

It is, however, observed that in case the petitioner approaches the competent authority under the Punjab State Power Corporation Limited along with all supporting documents/certificates seeking extension for joining at the place of transfer, the same would be considered sympathetically.

Disposed of.
