RAJ SHEKHAR ATTRI, J.

The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure (in short, "Cr.P.C".) for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.142 dated 30.11.2018 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 406, 498A, 506 of Indian Penal Code (for short, "IPC") at Police Station Women Cell, Ludhiana.

Heard.

Earlier the application for anticipatory bail of the petitioner was dismissed vide CRM-M-6514-2019 on 28.5.2019.

ASI Sukhdev Singh submits that now he has been arrested and a compromise has been effected on 20.7.2019. An amount of ₹ 5 lacs has been paid to the complainant wife. Mr. Satish stated to be clerk of Shri Amit Goyal, Advocate has placed on record these documents.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case and

keeping in view the fact that conclusion of trial will take considerably long time, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner-Inderjit Singh Walia son of Shri Gurmit Singh Walia is ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate subject to following terms:-

- (a) The petitioner shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.
- (b) In the event of his absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioner shall stand withdrawn. The trial Court shall be competent to cancel his bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure his presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioner shall have to apply for bail afresh.
- (c) He shall not leave the country without the prior permission of the Court.
