Learned counsel for the petitioner states that even though during the pendency of the writ petition, an order granting relief to the petitioner has already passed on 23.02.2018, still the said order has not been complied with and the benefits have not been released to the petitioner so far. Counsel for the petitioner states that a representation was also moved by the petitioner for implementation of the order dated 23.02.2018.

Learned counsel for the respondents states that order dated 23.02.2018 will be implemented in letter and spirit within a period of two months from today and all the benefits for which the petitioner is found entitled for as per the order dated 23.02.2018, will also be released to her within above said period.

In view of the undertaking given by counsel for the respondents, counsel for the petitioner states that no further order is required to be passed.

The writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to comply with the undertaking and implement the order dated 23.02.2018 within a period of two months from today.

Compliance of the implementation be also sent to this Court as well.
