In compliance of order dated 23.05.2019, an affidavit has been filed on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 today in the Court and the same is taken on record. A copy thereof has been supplied to counsel for the petitioner.

Counsel for the respondents states that the proceedings, which were pending against the petitioner, have already attained finality and the petitioner has been imposed with a punishment of 5% cut in his pension for a period of two years, vide order dated 13.08.2019 (Annexure R-2).

Counsel for the petitioner very fairly states that as the respondents have passed an order of punishment, a liberty be given to the

petitioner to avail his appropriate remedy of appeal against the said order and further, in case after the decision in appeal, petitioner is still aggrieved against any action of the respondent(s), he be given liberty to seek the relief before the appropriate forum.

Dismissed as withdrawn, with the liberty, as prayed for.
