This is second petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.1 dated 11.06.2018 registered under Sections 306, 34 of IPC at Police Station Handesra, District Mohali.

The matching report suggests that earlier also, the petitioners have approached this Court seeking similar relief. This Court, vide order dated 28.08.2018, by a detailed order, had already dismissed the petitions filed by the petitioners for grant of anticipatory bail. Whereas the petition filed by petitioner No.2-Prince Kumar i.e. **CRM-M-32384-2018** titled as ***Prince Kumar Versus State of Punjab*** was dismissed vide order dated 28.08.2018, the petition filed by Raj Rani i.e. **CRM-M-34058-2018** titled as ***Raj Rani Versus State of Punjab*** and the petition filed by Davinder Sharma i.e. **CRM-M-32387-2018** titled as ***Davinder Sharma Versus State of***

Punjab, were also dismissed on 28.08.2018 (in terms of order of even date passed in CRM-M-32384-2018).

No fresh ground has been made out to admit the petitioners on anticipatory bail.
