JITENDRA CHAUHAN, J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the salary for the period in issue has been paid and GPF Number has now been allotted. However, the issue pertaining to increment has not yet been settled.

Considering the fact that the substantial relief has been allowed to the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of. However, if grouse of the petitioner still subsists, the petitioner is free to move to the competent authority i.e. respondent No.3 who shall consider and decide the claim of the petitioner and pass an appropriate order within three months from the date of making the claim. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioner is admissible to him, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to him, within a period of six weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioner is not

admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
