By this petition, filed under the provisions of Section 439 of the Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks the concession of 'regular bail'.

No specific injury is stated to be attributed to the petitioner, with the sole injury on the person of the deceased attributed to one Kalu. The petitioner having been in custody for the past one year, with only 1 out of 15 prosecution witnesses having been examined so far, as per the instructions of the learned State counsel from ASI Bhupinder Singh, who is present in court to assist him, I deem it appropriate to admit the petitioner to bail during the pendency of the trial.

Consequently, without making any comment on the actual merits of the case, for or against the petitioner, this petition is allowed. The petitioner would be enlarged on bail, upon his furnishing adequate bail and

surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
