The prayer in the present writ petition is for refund of amount deposited by the petitioners towards CPF under the new pension scheme.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that the amount deposited towards CPF under the new pension scheme has not been refunded. He prays that he will be satisfied if the respondents are directed to treat the present petition as representation and consider and decide the same, in accordance with law expeditiously.

Learned State counsel submits that she is not averse to the suggestion put forth by learned counsel for the petitioners.

Heard.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the petitioners to submit a copy of this petition within six weeks from today before respondent No.1- The Principal Secretary, State of Punjab, Department of Technical Education & Industrial Training, Mini Secretariat, Punjab, Sector 9-C, Chandigarh, who shall treat the present petition as representation and consider and decide

the same within a period of six week from the receipt of the certified copy of the judgment. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioners is admissible to them, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to them, within a period of six weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioners are not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
