AVNEESH JHINGAN, J. (Oral)

The present contempt petition has been filed pleading that there is wilful disobedience of the order dated 5.3.2019 passed by this Court in CWP No. 5778 of 2019. The operative part of the said order is reproduced below:

“In view of the above, without advertng to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Gurugram-respondent No. 1 to consider aand decide the legal notice dated 4.9.2018 (Annexure P-1) within six weeks from the date of receipt of the certified copy of the judgment. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioner is admissible to him, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to him, within a period of six weeks

thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioner is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.”

The respondent had to take a decision on the legal notice of the petitioner within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

As per the averments made in the petition, copy of the order passed by this Court was delivered to the respondent on 29.3.2019 but there is no proof attached. Let atleast now copy be supplied to the respondent and in case of doing the needful, the respondent shall ensure compliance of the order dated 5.3.2019 within six weeks from the receipt of copy of this order. In case of non-compliance, costs may be imposed which shall be recoverable from the defaulting official.

With the aforesaid observation, the contempt petition stands disposed of.
