This petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 78 dated 24.03.2019, registered under Sections 379-B and 34 of the IPC at Police Station Sadar, Amritsar.

As per allegations in the FIR, recorded on the statement of complainant Jeeto Pashwan, it is stated that on 23.03.2019, he was going back to home and in the meantime, two boys came on a motorcycle and snatched his mobile phone and Rs. 52,00/-. It is further stated in the FIR that on inquiry made by the complainant himself, he came to know that aforesaid motorcycle was being driven by petitioner Rahul Sharma and one Baldeep Kumar Bali was sitting on the pillion seat.

HC Bharat Bhushan is present in Court and has filed custody certificate. As per the custody certificate, the petitioner is in judicial custody for the last 03 months and 28 days and he is not involved in any other case. HC Bharat Bhushan submitted that challan has already been presented in this case.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, considering the fact that the petitioner is in judicial custody for the last 03 months and 28 days and he is not involved in any other case and also in view of the fact that challan has already been presented; the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
