Petitioners have filed the instant petition seeking a mandamus for directing the official respondents to protect their life and liberty by voicing an apprehension and threat to the same at the hands of private respondents No.4 to 6.

Both the petitioners are stated to have attained the age of majority. Petitioner No.1 is stated to be 26 years old and petitioner No.2 is 27 years old.

It has been averred that petitioner No.1 was earlier married to respondent No.4 but on account of harassment and cruel treatment meted out she has left her matrimonial home and is currently staying with petitioner No.2

It is stated to be a live-in relationship.

Without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the instant writ petition in terms of granting liberty to the petitioners to approach respondent No.3, on the limited aspect as regards threat to their life.

respondent No.3 i.e. SHO Police Station Ajitwal, District Moga, would be obligated to look into the matter and thereafter to take steps as he may deem fit and as warranted in accordance with law.

It is clarified that this Court has not opined on the relationship/liaison between the parties.

Disposed of.
