The present contempt petition has been filed alleging wilful disobedience of the order dated 14.1.2019 passed by this Court in CWP No. 20497 of 2015. The operative part of the order is reproduced below:

“It is, however, made clear that payment of monetary benefits to the petitioner herein is restricted to 38 months prior to filing of present writ petition. The respondents are directed to make the calculations accordingly and pay the arrears to the petitioner for said 38 months within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.”

As per the order quoted above, the respondents had to make the calculations and pay the arrears to the petitioner for 38 months within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the

There is nothing on record to show that certified copy of the order has been supplied to the respondents. Let atleast now copy of order be supplied to the respondents and in case of doing the needful, the respondents shall ensure compliance of the order dated 14.1.2019 within three weeks from the receipt of copy of this order. In case of non-compliance, costs may be imposed which shall be recoverable from the defaulting official.

With the aforesaid observation, the contempt petition stands disposed of.
