The grievance of the petitioner herein is that he is serving the respondents as a Class-IV employee since 2006, but his services have not been regularized. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the case of the petitioner is squarely covered by the regularization policies of the State of Punjab dated 18.03.2011 and 17.11.2011 contained at Annexures P-9 and P-12 respectively, still benefit thereof has not been accorded to the petitioner. The representation dated 14.06.2019(Annexure P-23) submitted by the petitioner has not been adverted to by the respondents.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Anu Chatrath, Sr. Advocate assisted by Ms. Ambika Bedi, AAG Punjab puts in appearance on behalf of respondents-State.

Given the nature of order being passed and keeping in view the aforesaid, no further proceedings or pleadings are warranted in this case.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to pass a speaking order by objectively considering the contentions as raised in the representation dated 14.06.2019(Annexure P-23) along with the contents of

the instant writ petition by treating the same as supplementary representation as also keeping in view the contentions of learned counsel for the petitioner, as noted above, in accordance with law.

Let the needful be done within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. In the event the petitioner is found entitled to the benefits, as claimed by him, the same be accorded to him within a period of two months thereafter.
