The petitioner having absented himself from the trial Court on 18.1.2019, after which obviously many dates of hearing have gone by, the first being 28.1.2019 as per the order dated 18.1.2019, and he having approached this Court only six months later with a so called explanation, that he was sick from 15.1.2019 to 21.2.2019, (he having placed on record in the form of a prescription slip from a private hospital in Sardulgarh, District Mansa, advising him bed rest for one week), I find no ground to entertain this petition, which is consequently dismissed, the petitioner not even having bothered to determine right uptill now, as to what the next date of hearing was in the case in which he was supposed to appear in, after 18.1.2019.

However, upon the petitioner surrendering before the trial Court and filing any application for bail under Section 439 of the Cr.P.C., that would be decided on its own merits as expeditiously as possible.
