In the present writ petition, the grievance which is being raised by the petitioner is that the petitioner is entitled for travelling allowance and dearness allowance, which payments have not been made to the petitioner without any valid justification.

Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that though all the bills with regard to the travelling allowance have already been submitted to the respondents more than once but the respondents without any valid justification, have kept the same pending.

The prayer of the petitioner is for issuance of a direction to the respondents to release the pending travelling allowance and dearness allowance, forthwith.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that for the relief which has been claimed in the present writ petition, the petitioner has submitted to the respondents a representation dated 16.11.2018 (Annexure P-8) which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said representation by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by him in the representation dated 16.11.2018 (Annexure P-8), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the representation dated 16.11.2018 (Annexure P-8), within a period of three months from the receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case, it is found that the petitioner is entitled for any monetary benefits after the decision of the legal notice, the same should also be paid to him within three months thereafter.
