By this petition, filed under the provisions of Section 439 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks the concession of 'regular bail'.

Without making any comment on the actual merits of the case, it being seen that the petitioner was allegedly apprehended with the police party using a private vehicle and it not being denied that there was no number etc. of the private vehicle given as required even as per the directions issued by the DGP Punjab, and the allegation of the counsel for the petitioner being that the petitioner was actually picked up from home, without making any comment on the actual merits thereof, with it also seen that he is in custody for about one year, with the trial still not near conclusion, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be admitted to bail upon his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
