SHEKHER DHAWAN, J.

Present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure is for grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.68 dated 02.06.2019 under Sections 379-B and 34 IPC registered at Police Station Satnampura, District Kapurthala.

2. Allegations against the petitioner are that he alongwith co-accused Tilka, by putting the complainant under threat of *dattar*, snatched his purse and mobile phone.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case and he is ready to join the investigation.

4. Learned State counsel opposed the bail application on the ground that the allegations against the petitioner are serious in nature and require effective investigation.

5. Having considered the submissions made by learned counsel for the parties and above facts, this Court is of the considered view that the petitioner would be required for effective investigation of this case. No case is made out for release of the petitioner on anticipatory bail.

6. Resultantly, the present petition stands dismissed.
