Present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for seeking pre-arrest bail to the petitioner, namely, Parminder Singh, in case FIR No. 83, dated 28.03.2017, registered under Sections 466, 467, 468, 469, 471, 472, 420 and 120-B IPC, at Police Station Daba, Ludhiana, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that allegations in the present FIR are mainly against Vijay Kumar Goyal and petitioner is not involved in any way for commission of alleged offence. He has been implicated in the present case as per provisions of Section 120-B of Indian Penal Code. The modus operandi of the complainant is to implicate innocent peoples in false cases and then blackmail to them. Learned counsel further contended that petitioner is ready to join the investigation.

Learned State counsel as well as complainant of this case while opposing the bail application, contended that petitioner would be required for the purpose of effecting investigation as the matter pertains to forging of order of Hon'ble Apex Court and the petitioner was instrumental in forging and fabricating the orders of the Hon'ble Apex Court.

Having considered the submissions of the learned counsel for the parties and appraisal of the record of this case, the Court is of the considered view that the allegations levelled against present petitioner and co-accused are very serious in nature and the same relates to forging and fabricating the order of the Hon'ble Apex Court. The matter requires intensive investigation and no case is made out for interim bail to the present petitioner and as such, present petition for anticipatory bail is dismissed.
