ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.23 dated 16.01.2019, under Sections 323, 326, 506 & 34 IPC (Section 307 IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Asauda, District Jhajjar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the FIR is outcome of a sudden fight between friends while they were consuming liquor. The petitioner is alleged to have been armed with a danda and he has caused danda blows to the complainant. The complainant has fully recovered from the injuries. The petitioner is 22 years of age and he is in custody for over 9 months since the date of his arrest on 20.01.2019.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Yomesh Kumar, states that 4 out of 17 prosecution witnesses have been examined.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner, especially when the petitioner is 22 years of age, he is in custody for over 9 months, he is not involved in any other case and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
