Petitioners have appeared in person and have been heard.

Petitioner No.1 is stated to be 29 years old and petitioner No.2 is 35 years old.

As per the averments made in the petition, petitioner No.1 was married to respondent No.4 and out of wedlock, three children have been born. Petitioner No.1 submits that on account of the cruelty and harassment meted out by her husband i.e. respondent No.4, she was left with no other option but to leave her matrimonial home. Petitioner No.1 is now stated to be staying with petitioner No.2.

Petitioners voice an apprehension of threat to their life at the hands of respondent No.4.

Without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition as also the submissions advanced by the petitioners who have appeared in person, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the instant writ petition in terms of granting liberty to the petitioners to approach the S.H.O., Police Station Uchana, District Jind confined to the aspect of threat to their life.

In the eventuality of any such application being made, respondent No.3 would be obligated to look into the matter and take steps as he may deem fit and as warranted in accordance with law.

It is, however, clarified that this Court has not opined on the relationship/liason between the petitioners herein.
