Learned counsel for the petitioners, at the outset, points out that the claim of the petitioners has been conceded in para 3 of the reply filed by respondents No.1 and 2.

2. The said position is not controverted by learned State counsel.

3. Even otherwise, I am of the view that in the speaking order dated 03.07.2015 (Annexure R-1), it has been clearly stated that the petitioners are entitled to usual pay scale sanctioned for the post, which they were holding as on 01.01.1986, as per the provisions contained in The Punjab Pay Scales of Teachers Act, 2004, present writ petition is rendered infructuous.

4. In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to grant the benefits to the

petitioners within a period of 3 months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order failing which the petitioners shall be entitled to interest @ 8% per annum from the date of their entitlement till the actual payment thereof.
