**FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (ORAL)**

This order shall dispose off first anticipatory bail application filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. by petitioner Gurmeet Singh in case bearing FIR No.0073 dated 09.06.2019 registered at Police Station Dayalpura, District Bathinda under Sections 323, 498-A, 34 IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the orders of interim bail dated 25.07.2019 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined investigations which is not controverted by learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Baldev Singh, who submits that the petitioner is no longer required for further investigation and nothing is to be recovered from him and that he has no objection if the interim order is made absolute.

In view of what has been stated above and in the light of orders passed earlier, the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 25.07.2019 is made absolute on the same terms and conditions till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan). Thereafter, he will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
