Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in complaint bearing No. SC-179/2018 dated 25.01.2018 titled as “Hartej Singh @ Teji and another vs Kuldeep Kaur and another”, filed under Section 3(i)(x) of the Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 and Sections 323, 506 read with Section 34 IPC.

On 25.07.2019, the following order was passed:

“Counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are ready to surrender before the trial Court and face the proceedings, in accordance with law.

Notice of motion for 19.08.2019.

In the meantime, the petitioners are directed to surrender before the trial Court within a period of 10 days from today and the trial Court will release the petitioners on interim bail subject to their furnishing bail/surety bonds.”

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners,

in pursuance to the order dated 25.07.2019, have already appeared before the trial Court and they have been released on interim bail. A copy of the order, passed by the trial Court, is also placed on record.

Learned counsel for the State has not disputed the factual position.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and order dated 25.07.2019 is made absolute, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
