On 24.07.2019, following order was passed by this Court:-

“Learned senior counsel appearing for the petitioners while drawing attention of the Court to the role attributed to the petitioners, has submitted that the petitioners were unarmed and only allegation against the petitioners is that they pushed Kuldeep with force and therefore, he fell down. He further submits that the injury inflicted upon the first informant-Lovepinder Singh is alleged to have been caused by Hardeep Singh who is not the applicant. He further submits that the injuries to other injured i.e. Kuldeep are all simple in nature.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Ajay Kamboj, Advocate has put in appearance on

behalf of the first informant (complainant).

On asking of the Court, Mr. Munish Bansal, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the State of Haryana. A copy of the paper book be handed over to learned State counsel during course of the day.

Adjourned to 20.09.2019.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioners shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2), Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Pardeep Kumar, has submitted that the petitioners have joined investigation, cooperated and not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view thereof, order dated 24.07.2019 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
