Present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.71 dated 03.03.2017 under Sections 379, 411, 413, 473 of IPC, registered at Police Station Salem Tabri, Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that the petitioner is not involved in the alleged offence and he was arrested in this false case, and now he is ready to join the investigation.

Learned State counsel contended that, in terms of order dated 17.08.2019, the petitioner fails to appear before the trial Court on or before 23.08.2019 to seek regular bail. Earlier his bail was cancelled on account of his non appearance on 01.03.2019 and the conduct of the petitioner does not deserve the concession of bail.

Having considered the submissions made by learned counsel

for the petitioner and appraisal of case file, this Court is of the considered

opinion that the petitioner fails to appear before the trial Court on or before 23.08.2019 and seek regular bail. Earlier his bail was cancelled on account of non appearance on 01.03.2019 and as such, no case is made out for granting anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

In view of the above, the present petition stands dismissed.
