**FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (ORAL)**

Allegations against the petitioner Nanha alias Narender in this first regular bail application under Section 439 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.131 dated 20.06.2019 under Sections 452, 506, 354A1(1), 354B and 354D IPC pertaining to Police Station Julana, District Jind, before this Court have been levelled by a married lady aged around 55 years. In her complaint she alleges that on 20.06.2019 in the morning while she was present at the Gheer (courtyard for tying animals), accused in an inebriated state trespassed into the said place and molested the complainant leading to registration of the present case and arrest of the petitioner the same very day.

Learned counsel for the petitioner Mr. Ashwani Gaur, Advocate inter alia contends that the petitioner is behind bars for almost

four months and there is only a simplicitor dispute over the Bara/Gheer and that the petitioner has been falsely implicated.

Learned State counsel Mr. Baljinder Singh Virk, Dy. Advocate General, Haryana on instructions from SI Parveen though has duly accepted the facts brought to the notice of this Court by learned counsel for the petitioner, however, has sought to oppose the grant of bail on the grounds of heinousness of the offence.

Appreciating the arguments of the two sides, the petitioner is behind bars since a long time. In the light of allegations levelled and the fact that the trial is not likely to conclude in the near future, this Court is of the opinion that it is a fit case to allow bail to the petitioner as no useful purpose will be served by keeping him in custody in the present case. Accordingly, he is ordered to be released on regular bail to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Jind. However, it is made clear that anything observed herein shall not be construed as an expression on the merits of the case.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
