AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner has approached this Court, praying for a direction to respondent-Municipal Corporation officials to construct and carry out the work as per the demarcation got done by the revenue officials for land bearing Khewat No.4211 min//4228, Khatoni NO.7130, Khasra No.4518 (22-7), 4853 (0-18), 4854 (17-0), 4855 min (19-6), 4886 (0-6), 4887 (14-17), 8826/1 (3-17), 8847 (2-0), 8848 (0-4), 8857 (0-14), 8877 (2-2), 9003 (9-6), 9004 (15-2), 9082 (4-1), 9690 (149-8), 10398/226 (1-10), 10403/2275 (0-8), 10406/2281 (0-8), 10407/2282 (0-5), 10409/2283 (0-15), 13305/210 (0-6) as the Municipal Corporation is raising construction of the drain over the land of the petitioner by demolishing the house. To assert this fact, he places reliance upon demarcation report as also the site plan, which have been placed on record as Annexures P-4 and P-5.

There are disputed questions of facts, which cannot be gone into in the writ petition and, therefore, this Court would not exercise its writ jurisdiction. Petitioner, if so advised, may avail of his remedy in accordance with law before an appropriate Forum.

With the above observation, the writ petition stands dismissed.
