The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.48, dated 06.07.2019, under Sections 406, 420 IPC, Section 24 of the Immigration Act and Section 13 of the Punjab Travel Professional Regulation Act, 2014, registered at Police Station City Banga, District SBS Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations in the FIR are that the petitioner and her husband had taken a sum of ₹ 80,000/- for sending the son of the complainant to Kuwait. He also contends that the petitioner is 24 year old lady and has been falsely implicated in this case. The petitioner is not involved in any other case. He also contends that the petitioner has compromised the matter with the complainant and has furnished copies of the compromise and the affidavit of the complainant in this regard which are taken on record.

This Court, by the order dated 24.07.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating/Arresting Officer and join the investigation and in the event of her arrest, she was to be released on ad-interim

bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Kulvir Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and the petitioner having joined investigation and not required for custodial interrogation, the order dated 24.07.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. She shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
