This petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.178 dated 13.06.2019 under Sections 406, 420 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station Sohana, District SAS Nagar, Punjab.

On 25.07.2019, while issuing notice of motion to the respondent-State, the interim protection was extended to the petitioner. The said order reads as under:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the FIR itself contains the fact that the property in question, which was earlier agreed to be sold to the petitioner was in fact disposed off by way of sale in favour of the some other persons. It is pointed out that at the instance of the petitioner, FIR No.520 dated 22.10.2018 (Annexure P-8) was already registered against the complainant in the present FIR. He submits that the dispute is purely of civil nature and founded on the documentary material.

According to him, custodial interrogation of the petitioner may not be required.

Notice of motion for 28.11.2019.

In the meanwhile, petitioner shall join the investigation and would come present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, he shall be admitted to interim bail on his furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel who is assisted by SI Parkash Masih has apprised the Court that pursuant to the order dated 25.07.2019 passed by this Court, the petitioner has not joined the investigation.

Considering the conduct of the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed.
