The writ petition filed by Union of India challenging the order of the Central Administrative Tribunal, Chandigarh Bench, Chandigarh was disposed of on 23.8.2018 with a direction to prepare fresh Reservation Roster within four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

During the pendency of the contempt petition, the Reservation Roster has been prepared on 29.8.2019. The petitioners have moved CM No. 20106-CII of 2019 to produce on record the affidavit showing that there are certain errors which are continuing from previous roster.

The grievance raised is that though fresh Reservation Roster has been prepared, but roster points have not been rightly fixed.

The said aspect cannot be gone into in the contempt proceedings.

As the directions of this court have been complied with, no case for contempt is made out. The present petition is dismissed. However, the petitioners would be at liberty to avail remedies available in accordance with law for the grievance against fresh roster points.
