Counsel for the petitioners argues that the petitioners are entitled for the benefit of the judgment rendered by this Court in CWP No.25733 of 2012 on 22.10.2013, which has been upheld by the Division Bench of this Court while deciding LPA No.352 of 2015 on 31.8.2016 with certain modifications. Counsel for the petitioner argues that once the petitioners are similarly situated as the petitioner in CWP No.25733 of 2012, they are entitled for the same benefit as being extended by the Government of Punjab while implementing the judgment dated 22.10.2013 as modified by the Division Bench in LPA No.352 of 2015 decided on 31.08.2016.

Counsel for the petitioners states that for the relief which has been sought in the present writ petition, the petitioners have served the respondents with a legal notice dated 10.04.2019 (Annexure P/8), which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioners will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said legal notice.

In view of the request made, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioners, the respondents are directed to decide legal notice dated 10.04.2019 (Annexure P/8) by passing a speaking order within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
