Pursuant to the order dated 27.08.2019, the report of the learned JMIC, Batala, dated 09.09.2019, has been received, stating therein that the statements of the petitioner as also of the complainant-respondent No.2, Manjit Kaur, were recorded before that Court in respect of the compromise stated to have been reached between the parties, with the statement of one Head Constable Gurinder Singh also having been recorded, to the effect that there was no other person involved in the occurrence except the petitioner, Gurpreet Singh, Sukhwinder Kaur and Harjeet Singh, and that the FIR qua Sukhwinder Kaur and Harjeet Singh has already been quashed by this Court vide an order passed on 14.02.2019, in CRM-M-12998-2016.

As per the assessment of the learned Magistrate, the compromise effected between the parties is without any pressure or coercion. Further, the FIR already having been quashed by this Court qua the co-accused of the petitioner, though obviously the victim has already

died, the allegation being the commission of an offence punishable under Section 306 of the IPC, but the complainant being his widow, who has admitted to having compromised the matter with the petitioner, the petition is allowed and FIR No. 64 dated 27.05.2015, registered against the petitioner at Police Station Civil Lines Batala, for the alleged commission of an offence punishable under Section 306 of the IPC, along with all proceedings emanating therefrom, is hereby quashed.
