As per the information dated 28.11.2018 (Annexure P-6), the respondents have taken steps to retrench 41 candidates who have been selected as Drivers on account of anomalies in the selection process.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has further referred to an order passed by this Court in CWP-18106-2018 whereby in similar circumstances, the Department has taken steps to retrench 41 candidates and this petition has been disposed of by giving direction to the respondents to look into the legal notice of the petitioners therein.

The petitioners in the present case are claiming that 41 posts have become vacant and they have requisite qualification for the post of Drivers, they may be considered for appointment in accordance with law. Learned counsel for the petitioners has mentioned in para 3 of the writ petition the gradation list of the petitioners.

A legal notice dated 08.01.2018 (Annexure P-5) has been sent

in this regard.

Keeping in view the information given to the petitioners (Annexure P-6), this petition is being disposed of by giving direction to the respondents to look into legal notice dated 08.01.2018 (Annexure P-5) and the appropriate steps be taken in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
