Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.20 dated 19.06.2019, under Sections 323, 324, 295, 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Narot Jaimal Singh, District Pathankot.

This Court, while issuing notice of motion on 25.07.2019, passed the following order:-

“ *Notice of motion for 06.09.2019.*

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest, the petitioner be released on interim bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

At this stage, Mr. Gaurav Sharma, Advocate, has appeared and filed power of attorney on behalf of respondent No.2. ”

Today, ASI Angrej Singh, who is present in the Court, submits that petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of order dated 25.07.2019 and his custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of above, interim order dated 25.07.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and the present petition stands disposed off.

It is made clear that the petitioner shall fully co-operate with the Investigating Officer as and when called for further investigation.

The observations may not be considered as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
