The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.92 dated 25.06.2019, under Sections 384 & 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Model Town, Panipat, District Panipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner are that he along with a lady tried to blackmail the complainant. He also contends that the petitioner is 26 years of age and he is not involved in any other case. He is in custody for over 2 ½ months since his arrest on 25.06.2019.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Sachin Kumar, states that Rs.2500/- in cash and a mobile phone have been recovered from the petitioner. He further states that although the investigation in the case is complete but the charges are yet to be framed.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner especially when the petitioner is 26 years of age, he is not involved in any other case and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
