This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for the issuance of a writ, in the nature of certiorari, seeking quashing the impugned order dated 28.02.2018 (Annexure P-3) issued by respondent No.3 rejecting the claim of the petitioner for old age pension on flimsy ground of mistake in the record of the Election Commission of India regarding her age by ignoring the correct age recorded in the Aadhar Card (Annexure P-1) in most illegal, arbitrary, discriminatory and unconstitutional manner.

Heard.

The application for sanction of old age pension has been rejected on the ground that he has not appended ration card with the application, which is a mandatory requirement for sanction of old age pension as per the orders issued by Additional Chief Secretary, Govt. of Haryana, Department of Social Justice and Empowerment, Haryana Civil

Secretariat, Chandigarh (Annexure R-2).

In this view of the matter, the Court is not inclined to accept the prayer made in the petition. However, in case fresh application is made along with Ration Card and the documents required in terms of the policy (Annexure R-2), the respondents shall consider the same expeditiously.
