Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.242 dated 11.06.2019, under Section 379 IPC, registered at Police Station Baldev Nagar, District Ambala.

On 25.07.2019, this Court had passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner does not own any land or tubewell and the only allegation in the FIR is that broken piece of harrow was found near the tubewell of the petitioner.

Notice of motion for 27.11.2019.

In the meanwhile, petitioner shall join the investigation and would come present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, he shall be admitted to interim bail on his furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified

under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel, who is assisted by HC Jai Kumar, has apprised the Court that pursuant to order dated 25.07.2019 passed by this Court, the petitioner has not joined the investigation.

Considering the conduct of the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed.
