1. The writ petition was filed in the year 2015 when the post of Instructor for Cutting, Tailoring and Embroidery was advertised on contract basis. The petitioner was aggrieved qua the said advertisement on the ground that since she was already working on the said post on contract basis and therefore, her services could not be displaced by another contractual employee.

2. The services of the petitioner were dispensed with.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner would be satisfied in case her candidature is considered in accordance with law in the event said post is advertised afresh by the respondents.

4. In view of the aforesaid, writ petition is disposed of with the direction to the respondents that in the event post of Instructor for Cutting and Tailoring/Needle Work/Embroidery is advertised then the claim of the petitioner would be considered in accordance with law.
