[1] Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of the petitioner having been taken back in service on 17.01.2019 as Extension Lecturer, he may be permitted to withdraw the writ petition with liberty to pursue the claim qua payment of salary for the period the petitioner remained out of service from 20.08.2017 till date of rejoining.

[2] Learned Sr. DAG states that he has no objection to the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

[3] In view of the statement of learned counsel for the parties, the writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty as prayed for. Needless to mention, in case any representation is made within a period of two weeks, the same shall be considered and decided by the competent authority in accordance with law as expeditiously as possible preferably within three months from the date of receipt of representation as well as the certified copy of this order.
