HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI, J. (ORAL)

In the present application, the claim of the petitioner is against the Cooperative Society i.e. respondent No.2 for grant of the benefits after his retirement.

Counsel for respondents No.3 and 4 states that writ petition against the Cooperative Society is not maintainable and the respondents society is not amenable to the writ petition as the same is neither administered by the Government nor is being financially supported

by the Government in any manner so as to bring the said society under Article 12 of the Constitution of India to be amenable to the writ jurisdiction of this Court.

Counsel for respondents No.3 and 4 states that petitioner has an alternative remedy under the Punjab Cooperative Societies Act, 1961 for the redressal of his grievance.

Faced with this situation, counsel for the petitioner states that he may be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to approach the appropriate authorities under the Punjab Cooperative Societies Act, 1961 for redressal of his grievance.

Dismissed as withdrawn, with the liberty as prayed for.
